TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Surrey) (No. 1) Order 1983", authorising the stopping up of an area of footway of the High Street at Epsom in the county of Surrey to enable development consisting of two columns necessary as part of a pedestrian mall in connection with the town centre redevelopment to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Epsom and Ewell Borough Council under the said Act.
