Unless the Order is suspended or quashed as a consequence of any such application, any person who on 20th July 1983 has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order Relates may claim to be entitled to be compensated by the Wirral Borough Council in respect of any depreciation in the value of his or her interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable. ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

CHESTER CITY COUNCIL

*Chester City Council Traffic Regulation Orders
Becketts Lane; Tower Wharf; Princess Street/Northgate
Street/Hunters Wall.*

Notice is hereby given that, on 15th July 1983, the Council of the City of Chester, pursuant to arrangements made under the Local Government Act 1972 with Cheshire County Council, made Orders under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The Orders and their effects are as follows, the usual exemptions from which will apply:—

- (1) The City of Chester (Becketts Lane and Stocks Lane) (Restriction of Waiting Order 1983—operative date—18th July 1983.
To prohibit waiting at any time between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the following lengths of the south-west side of Becketts Lane:—
(a) from a point 40.23 metres (44 yards) north-west of its junction with Heath Lane to a point 75 metres north-west of its junction with Heath Lane; and
(b) from a point 100 metres north-west of its junction with Heath Lane to a point 113.38 metres (124 yards) north-west of its junction with Heath Lane.
- (2) The City of Chester (Tower Wharf) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983—operative date—18th July 1983.
To prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of Tower Wharf:—
Both sides from a point 80 feet (approximately 24 metres) south-west of its junction with Raymond Street to a point 80 metres south-west of its junction with Raymond Street.
- (3) The City of Chester (Princess Street/Northgate Street/Hunters Walk) (Traffic Management) Order 1983—operative date—31st July 1983.
(a) To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the length of Market Square between the south side of Hunter Street and the north side of Princess Street.
(b) To prohibit any vehicle from entering the Lower Bus Exchange Point from Hunters Walk.
(c) To prohibit any vehicle, except a bus, from entering the Lower Bus Exchange Point from Princess Street.
