

Disabled drivers will be permitted to wait for periods of up to 2 hours with no return within 1 hour on those lengths of road where waiting is prohibited and will be exempt from the limited waiting provisions.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any Instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 22nd July 1983, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The Trunk Road (A259) (Various Roads, Hythe) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1983

The Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on the Folkestone—Honiton Trunk Road (A259) at Hythe in the District of Shepway in the County of Kent.

The effect of the Order, which comes into operation on 23rd July 1983 is to prohibit waiting on the sides of the roads specified in the Schedule attached to this notice. The waiting restrictions covered by the Trunk Road (Various Roads, Hythe) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979 have been revoked.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein. There is also a provision exempting disabled persons' vehicles which display in the relevant prescribed position a disabled person's (orange coloured) badge.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provisions contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Acts, or on the ground that any requirement of those Acts, or of regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 23rd July 1983, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

Sides of road at Hythe in the District of Shepway in the County of Kent

1. East Street, both sides, from its junction with Prospect Road to a point 45 metres eastwards measured from the centre of the roundabout situated at its junction with High Street, Station Road and East Street.
2. Prospect Road, both sides, from its junction with East Street to its junction with Rampart Road (Main Carriageway).

3. Rampart Road (Main Carriageway), both sides, from its junction with Prospect Road to its junction with Red Lion Square.
4. Rampart Road (Slip Road)
 - (a) North side, from its junction with Rampart Road (Main Carriageway) to about 12 metres east of that junction.
 - (b) North side, from 76 metres west of the access road to Bank Street to 46 metres west of the same junction.
 - (c) South side, from its junction with Rampart Road (Main Carriageway), to a point 60 metres east of the same junction. (10 SI)

**THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968,

Portugal: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973, 1979 and 1981 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351, S.I. 1979 No. 1426 and S.I. 1981 No. 1085) give notice that they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificate produced in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 5th October 1972 for the importation of meat and meat products from Portugal, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 20th August 1982 is hereby revoked.
