

Exceptions to the proposed Order will permit heavy commercial vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes gross weight to proceed in those lengths of road specified for the purposes of proceeding to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent thereto, for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent thereto or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled thereupon, building, industrial or demolition operations, removal of obstructions to traffic, maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road or the services therein, fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicle.

A copy of the proposed Orders together with a map showing the restricted roads and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley and (ii) Askern Library, Station Road, Askern.

Little Burstead Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that Basildon District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") has authorised the designation of a conservation area at Little Burstead, Billericay, Essex, with effect from 12th July 1983.

The conservation area boundary includes property at the eastern end of Tye Common Road, around Stockwell Hall and fronting Clock House Road between Botney Hill Road and the War Memorial; the Rectory and Little Burstead House and property fronting Laidon Common Road between the War Memorial and Brook House. The boundary takes account of property and field boundaries and follows full public consultation.

The effect of the designation is to identify this part of Little Burstead as an area of special architectural or historic interest and to require the Council and the Secretary of State for the Environment to pay special attention to the character and appearance of the area when exercising their powers of planning control. The Council may also adopt a policy of enhancing and improving the area. In a conservation area, permission is required for certain works to buildings (e.g. demolition) where it would not otherwise be necessary.

A plan showing the extent of the area designated as a conservation area is available for inspection at the offices of the Council's Technical Services Division (Planning), Keay House, 88 Town Square, Basildon between the hours of 9 a.m.—1 p.m. and 2 p.m.—5 p.m.
