## CLWYD COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Clwyd (Pinfold Lane and Robin Hood Lane, Northop Hall) (Weight Restriction) (Amendment) Order 198 .*

Notice is hereby given that the Clwyd County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) Revoke the County of Clwyd (Pinfold Lane and Robin Hood Lane, Northop Hall) (Weight Restriction) Order 1976 which prohibits any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 2 tons from proceeding in either of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.
- (2) Prohibit any vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 2 tonnes from proceeding in that length of Pinfold Lane, Northop Hall (C105) in the Borough of Delyn and the District of Alyn and Deeside in the County of Clwyd which extends from its junction with the A55 to its junction with Robin Hood Lane (U199), a point approximately 23 metres south of the entrance to the property known as Ewloe Wood House, except vehicles requiring access to property situated on or adjacent to that length of road.

The reasons for proposing to make the Order are that the Hawarden By-pass will sever Robin Hood Lane and will therefore make it impossible for heavy vehicles to use the road for access onto the A55, and the existing 2 tons weight limit on Pinfold Lane will be substituted with a similar weight limit of 2 tonnes in accordance with legislation concerning the metrication of weight restrictions.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Shire Hall, Mold, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposed Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the undersigned by 31st October 1983.

*Pinfold Lane* (C105), from its junction with the A55 to its junction with Robin Hood Lane (U199), a point approximately 25 yards south of the entrance to the property known as Ewloe Wood House.

*Robin Hood Lane* (U199), from its junction with the A55 to its junction with Pinfold Lane (C105), a point approximately 25 yards south of the entrance to the property known as Ewloe Wood House.

## CLWYD COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Clwyd (Holywell Road and Mold Road, Ewloe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Clwyd County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading, unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to allow vehicles displaying both a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc to wait in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day).

The Trunk Road (Holywell Road, Ewloe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971 as amended by the Trunk Road (Holywell Road, Ewloe) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Variation) Order 1971 will be revoked.

The classifications and numbers of the roads specified in the Schedule to this notice are those it is proposed will apply upon completion of the Hawarden By-pass, and the roads are re-classified.

The reason for proposing to make the Order is that the restrictions are considered to be an integral part of the new road scheme and are necessary in the interests of road safety.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Shire Hall, Mold, during normal office hours.

*Holywell Road* (B5125), both sides from its newly constructed junction with Mold Road (B5127), near the property known as the Boar's Head Public House, in a north-westerly direction to a point 36 metres north-west of the vehicular access to the property known as Westhaven, a distance of approximately 244 metres.

*Mold Road* (B5127), both sides, including the layby; from the newly constructed Ewloe Roundabout in a south-westerly direction to a point adjacent to the westerly boundary of the property known as Hatherley, a distance of approximately 358 metres.

Notice is hereby given that the Clwyd County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, the effect of which will be to revoke the County of Clwyd (Brookside, Northrop Hall) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1980 which prohibits any vehicle proceeding in Brook side, Northrop Hall (C105) in the Borough of Delyn in the County of Clwyd from turning right on to the Trunk Road A55.
