#### DACORUM DISTRICT COUNCIL

##### *The Dacorum District Council (Various Roads) Traffic (No. 2) Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that the Dacorum District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertford in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, hereby give notice of their intention to make a Traffic Regulation Order with the following effect:

- (1) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at all times in the lengths of road shown in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (2) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in any of the lengths of road shown in the Second Schedule to this notice;
- (3) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in *The Nap, Kings Langley* on both sides for 20 yards (18 metres) east of its junction with the A41.
- (4) Previous Orders and parts of Orders which are superseded by the proposals will be revoked.
- (5) The bus only link between *Aycliffe Drive* and *Cambrian Way, Hemel Hempstead* and associated no entry restrictions will no longer be required with the opening of the east/west link road and the Order affecting this will be revoked.
- (6) Cycling will be prohibited along *Footpath 61 Hemel Hempstead* between *Forest Avenue* and *Seaton Road* including the section which was recently diverted.
- (7) A drafting anomaly in the Dacorum District Council (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976 will be corrected.

Exemptions from the proposed Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods;
- (c) emergency service vehicles;
- (d) disabled persons' vehicles;

and where necessary in connection with:

- (e) the maintenance of the road;
- (f) supply of gas, electricity and water;
- (g) delivery and collection of postal packets.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order, which together with the plans during the lengths of road affected and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at the Dacorum Civic Centre, Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead, or at the Council's Branch Offices at High Street, Berkhamsted.

Any objections to the proposed Order must be sent in writing, together with the grounds on which they are made, to be received by me no later than 14th November 1983.

#### SCHEDULE 1

##### *No Waiting at Any Time*

- (1) *The Nap, Kings Langley*, both sides, for 16 yards (15 metres) east and west of the junction with *Fisher Close*.
- (2) *Fisher Close, Kings Langley*, both sides, for 16 yards (15 metres) south of its junction with *The Nap*.
- (3) *St. John's Road, Hemel Hempstead*
  - (a) North side, from *Anchor Lane* to 16 yards (15 metres) east of *Wharf Road*.
  - (b) South side, for 16 yards (15 metres) east and west of *Wharf Road*.
  - (c) North-east and east sides from *Park Road* to *Station Road*.
- (4) *Wharf Road, Hemel Hempstead*, both sides, for 16 yards (15 metres) from *St. John's Road*.
- (5) *St. John's Road* service road leading to *Boxmoor Hall*
  - (a) North side, between *St. John's Road* and the eastern boundary of *No. 6 St. John's Road*.
  - (b) South side, for 12 yards (11 metres) east of *St. John's Road*.
- (6) *Church Lane, Kings Langley*
  - (a) Both sides, from 16 yards (15 metres) west of *Alexandra Road* to 16 yards (15 metres) north-east of the junction with *Waterside*.
  - (b) North side, for 16 yards (15 metres) east and west of *The Orchard*.
- (7) *The Orchard, Kings Langley*, both sides, for 7.5 yards (7 metres) from *Church Lane*.
- (8) *Castle Street, Berkhamsted*
  - (a) East side, from the *A41 High Street* to *Station Road*.
  - (b) West side, from *Station Road* to 60 yards (55 metres) south of *Mill Street*.
- (9) *Chapel Street, Berkhamsted*, both sides, for 16 yards (15 metres) from *Castle Street*.
- (10) *Dacorum Way, Hemel Hempstead*
  - (a) Both sides, from *Combe Street* for 150 yards (137 metres) northwards but excluding the parking bays on both the east and west sides.
  - (b) South side, for 50 yards (45 metres) west of *Marlowes*.
  - (d) North side, between points 22 yards (20 metres) and 27 yards (25 metres) west of *Marlowes*.
  - (e) North side, between points 69 yards (63 metres) and 75 yards (69 metres) west of *Marlowes*.
- (11) Access road on the north side of the *Pavilion*
  - (a) South side, for 16 yards (15 metres) west of *Marlowes*.
  - (b) North side, for 46 yards (42 metres) west of *Marlowes*.
- (12) Access road fronting the *Health Centre*, west side, for 25 yards (23 metres) north of the access road on the north side of the *Pavilion*.
- (13) Access road fronting the *Police Station* in *Combe Street, Hemel Hempstead*, for 22 yards (20 metres) east of *Dacorum Way*.
- (14) *Charles Street, Berkhamsted*
  - (a) South side, from *Kings Road* to 16 yards (15 metres) west of *Doctors Commons Road*.
  - (b) North side, for 38 yards (35 metres) west of *Kings Road*.
- (15) *Lincoln Court, Berkhamsted*, both sides, for 16 yards (15 metres) south of *Charles Street*.
- (16) *Doctors Commons Road, Berkhamsted*, both sides, for 16 yards (15 metres) south of *Charles Street*.
- (17) *Storey Street, Hemel Hempstead*, south-east side, from *A41 London Road* to *Weymouth Street*.
- (18) *Weymouth Street, Hemel Hempstead*, north-east side, for 16 yards (15 metres) from its junction with *Storey Street*.
- (19) *Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead*, west side
  - (a) From *Combe Street* to 35 yards (32 metres) north of *Midland Road*.
