Notice is hereby given that the Dacorum District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertford in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section I (1), (2), (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, hereby give notice of their intention to make a Traffic Regulation Order with the following effect:

- (1) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at all times in the lengths of road shown in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (2) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in any of the lengths of road shown in the Second Schedule to this notice
- (3) Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in *The Nap, Kings Langley* on both sides for 20 yards (18 metres) east of its junction with the A41.
