DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

The Trunk Road (A19) (24 Hour Main Carriageway Clearway) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on the East of Snaith to Sunderland Trunk Road (A19) in the Districts of South Tyneside, Sunderland and Easington in the Counties of Tyne and Wear and Durham.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on any of the main carriageways (including the carriageways of the slip roads) forming part of that length of the trunk road A19 which extends from its junction with the A184 Road at Testos Roundabout, Boldon southwards for a distance of about 20 miles to the Durham/Cleveland County Boundary just south of the A179/B1280 Interchange at Sheraton.

The prohibitions imposed by the Order will not apply:

- (a) to a vehicle waiting upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden;
- (b) so as to prevent a vehicle being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or of any of the services therein;
- (c) to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (d) to a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) to a vehicle being used by the Post Office for the purposes of delivering or collecting postal packets, or
- (f) to a vehicle waiting when the person in control of it is:
 - (i) required by law to stop;
 - (ii) obliged to stop to avoid an accident, or
 - (iii) prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposal and a statement explaining the Secretary of
