THE IMPORTATION OF EQUINE ANIMALS
ORDER 1979

Notice is hereby given that as provided by Article 4 of the Importation of Equines Animal Order 1979 the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food have with effect from 1st September 1983 issued the following General Licences with headings and conditions as detailed below:

New General Licences

Subject: Horses for Race, Show or Competition purposes.

1. Licence No: WOAD/JAN/H/83/4
Country: Denmark, Finland, Luxembourg, Netherlands and Sweden

This licences is valid through all ports and airports in Wales.

Conditions attached to licence.

1. The horse must be accompanied by a certificate on one sheet of paper only, in English and one language of the country from which the horse is to be exported. The Certificate must be signed by a veterinary surgeon duly authorised by the Government of the exporting country, stamped with his official stamp and stating that the horse has within 48 hours immediately preceding exportation, been examined by him and showed no signs or symptoms of infectious or contagious disease at the time of examination.
2. The horse must be identified by a completed silhouette. This may *either* be part of the health certificate mentioned above *or* contained within a passport/certificate of

identification issued by a responsible organisation of the exporting country. In the latter case the health certification must be annotated as follows:

"The horse certified on this health certificate is as described in horse passport/identification certificate No

Veterinary Surgeon's signature

NOTE. Health certification satisfying condition 1 above may be *incorporated* into a passport or certificate of identification issued by an internationally recognised equestrian organisation. Provided that document contains a completed silhouette, no other identification need be provided.
