PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT  
1975*Notice of the Issue of Submarine Pipe-Line Works  
Authorisations*

The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that six pipeline works authorisations have been issued to Hamilton Brothers Oil and Gas Ltd., whose registered office in the United Kingdom is at Cleveland House, 19 St. James's Square, London SW1Y 4LP, for the construction and use of:

- (i) two pipelines extending between the Duncan field manifold at 56° 11' 11.9" North and 02° 43' 27.54" East and the TW 58 manifold at 56° 10' 40.316" North and 02° 46' 51.234" East;
- (ii) a pipeline extending between Well 30/24-15 at 56° 11' 20.404" North and 02° 41' 19.248" East and the

Duncan field manifold at 56° 11' 11.9" North and 02° 43' 27.54" East;

- (iii) a pipeline extending between Well 30/24-17 at 56° 10' 47.10" North and 02° 43' 03.8" East and the Duncan field manifold at 56° 11' 11.9" North and 02° 43' 27.54" East;
- (iv) a pipeline extending between Well 30/24-19 at 56° 12' 01.18" North and 02° 40' 25.76" East and the Duncan field manifold at 56° 11' 11.9" North and 02° 43' 27.54" East;
- (v) a pipeline extending between Well 30/24-22 at 56° 11' 11.1" North and 02° 42' 10.8" East and the Duncan field manifold at 56° 11' 11.9" North and 02° 43' 27.54" East.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the pipelines may only be used to convey crude oil and its associated hydrocarbons. The pipelines may be used by the holder and certain other bodies specified in the works authorisations and, with the holder's agreement and with the consent of the Secretary of State by other persons. Hamilton Brothers Oil and Gas Ltd., has been appointed operators of the pipelines. (15 SD)

ABSTRACT WATER
