Notice is hereby given that the Norfolk County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below at any time.

TEST VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Borough Council of Test Valley (Off-Street Parking Places, Andover) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that on 6th October 1983 the Test Valley Borough Council made the above Order under sections 31 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to amend The Borough Council of Test Valley (Off-Street Parking Places, Andover) Order 1981, as follows:

- (1) To close Parking Place No. 1 (High Street) between 0001 and 1800 hours on Thursdays.
- (2) To delete existing Parking Places No. 3 (Corporation Yard, Bridge Street) and No. 13 (Corporation Yard Extension) and to substitute "No. 3 (Anton Mill Road Extension)" and "No. 13 (Borden Gates)".
- (3) To clarify the regulations governing the control and use of parking spaces reserved exclusively for disabled persons' vehicles.

The Order will come into effect on 24th October 1983. A copy of the Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the Municipal Offices, Beech Hurst, Weyhill Road, Andover, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 6th October 1983, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Season tickets, reserved space £350 per annum (expiring 30th September)*
