NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

Wychavon District Council

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf has made an Order entitled the County of Hereford and Worcester, Wychavon District Parish of North Claines (Footpath No. 10 (Part)) Public Path Diversion Order 1983, the effect of which will be to divert that part of footpath No. 10 which starts from a point marked A on the map approximately 60 yards (55 metres) east of the starting point on the Ombersley road (A449) which runs in a south-easterly direction for approximately 75 yards (68 metres) to a point at the end of the cul-de-sac known as Cornmeadow Green, shown as point B on the map, to a new line which commences at the aforementioned point A and runs in a south-easterly direction for approximately 33 yards (30 metres) to a point on a new estate road. It then follows the route of that new estate road for

approximately 28 yards (25 metres) then runs in a southerly-south-easterly direction for approximately 34 yards (31 metres) to rejoin the cul-de-sac known as Cornmeadow Green at the aforementioned point B. The lines and situations of the existing and proposed alternative highways are shown on the map annexed to the Order.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the Wychavon District Council and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Norbury House, Friar Street, Droitwich, Worcestershire WR9 8EE, during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the date of publication of this notice but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any Regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the Order he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application for the purpose to the High Court.

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY A PUBLIC PATH ORDER

The Kent County Council (FP 139 (Part) Wye and Brook, Ashford) Public Path Diversion Order 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2 (3) of the Sixth Schedule to the Highways Act 1980 that the Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to modify the Kent County Council (FP 139 (Part) Wye and Brook, Ashford) Public Path Diversion Order 1981, by adding to B of the Schedule the following:

"The new footpath shall enter Hook's Wood about 230 feet north of point B and shall continue through the narrowing isthmus of woodland generally along the line of an old cart track until re-emerging into Field OS 0039 at point B;"

Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way over Length of Footpath at Deepdale/Danesford, Hollinswood, Telford
