

(2) to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at any time in the length or on the sides of road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 5 and 6 to this notice and, in addition, to prohibit loading or unloading between:

(a) 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Friday on the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;

(b) 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. Monday to Friday on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice; and

(c) 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. Monday to Friday on the sides of road specified in Schedule 6 to this notice.

(3) to close the gap in the central reservation of the Newport-Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) Malpas Road at its junction with Woodlands Drive.

Exceptions in the Order will permit waiting for the following purposes:

(a) picking up or setting down passengers;

(b) building, industrial or demolition operations; and

(c) carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

The usual exceptions have also been provided in the Order for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Order to be revoked together with a plan and statement of reasons for making the Order may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Newport Borough Council, Civic Centre, Newport, during a period of 6 weeks from 18th November 1983.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Transport Highways and Planning Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting ref. WR15/3/87.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within the aforesaid period of 6 weeks apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULES

Lengths and sides of the Newport-Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) at Newport in the County of Gwent

SCHEDULE 1

Those lengths of the western side of the trunk road which extend:

(a) from a point 70 metres south of the south-eastern kerb-line of Blaen-y-Pant Crescent in a general northerly direction to a point 48 metres north-east of the northern kerb-line of Hollybush Avenue;

(b) from a point 78 metres north-east of the northern kerb-line of Hollybush Avenue in a general northerly direction to a point 115 metres south-western kerb-line of Westfield Drive;

(c) from a point 25 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Westfield Drive in a general northerly direction to a point 240 metres north of the north-eastern kerb-line of Westfield Drive; and

(d) from a point 275 metres north of the north-eastern kerb-line of Westfield Drive in a general northerly direction to a point at its junction with the south-western kerb-line of the southern arm of Russell Drive.

SCHEDULE 2

The eastern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Graig Park Road in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

SCHEDULE 3

Those lengths of the eastern side of the trunk road which extend:

(a) from a point 25 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Graig Park Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 45 metres; and

(b) from a point 48 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Graig Park Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 45 metres.

SCHEDULE 4

Those lengths of the western side of the trunk road which extend:

(a) from a point 25 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Westfield Drive in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 90 metres; and

(b) from a point 240 metres north of the north-eastern kerb-line of Westfield Drive in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 35 metres.

SCHEDULE 5

(a) That length of the trunk road comprising the roundabout at Malpas Interchange and which extends from the said roundabout in a general north-westerly direction to a point 70 metres south of the south-eastern kerb-line of Blaen-y-Pant Crescent.

(b) That length of the west side of the trunk road which extends from its junction with the southern arm of Russell Drive in a general north-westerly direction to a point 90 metres north-west of its junction with the north-western kerb-line of Whittle Drive.

(c) Those lengths of the eastern side of the trunk road which extend:

(i) from a point 70 metres south of the south-eastern kerb-line of Blaen-y-Pant Crescent in a north-easterly direction to a point 175 metres south-east of the south-eastern side of Llanover Close; and

(ii) from its junction with the north-western kerb-line of Larch Grove in a north-westerly direction to a point 104 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Montgomery Road.

SCHEDULE 6

Those lengths of the eastern side of the trunk road which extend:

(a) from a point 167 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Llanover Close in a north-westerly direction to a point 14 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Llanover Close;

(b) from a point 52 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Llanover Close in a general north-easterly direction to a point 120 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Graig Park Circle;

(c) from a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Graig Park Road in a general north-easterly direction to a point 28 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Graig Park Road; and

(d) from a point 75 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Pillmawr Road in a general north-easterly direction to a point at its junction with the south-eastern kerb-line of Larch Grove. (3 SI)
