The Trunk Road (A55) (Bodelwyddan, Clywd) *(Prohibition of Overtaking) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 12 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from overtaking any other moving vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedules to this notice. Nothing in the proposed Order will prevent any vehicle from overtaking any bicycle, not having a sideware attached.

A copy of the proposed Order, a copy of the Order to be revoked together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Rhuddlan Borough Council, Russell House, 34 Russell Road, Rhyl.

SCHEDULE 1

The eastbound carriageway of the length of the Chester-Bangor Trunk Road (A55) at Bodelwyddan in the County of Clwyd which extends from a point 369 yards west of its junction with Artillery Row in a general easterly direction for a distance of 1215 yards.

SCHEDULE 2

The westbound carriageway of the length of the Chester-Bangor Trunk Road (A55) at Bodelwyddan in the County of Clwyd which extends from a point 48 yards east of its junction with Engine Hill in a general westerly direction for a distance of 750 yards. (3 SI)

The Trunk Road (A55) (Bodelwyddan, Clywd) *(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 12 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on any day on the side of the road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions in the proposed Order will permit waiting for the following reasons:

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers ;
- (b) loading or unloading goods ;
- (c) building, industrial or demolition operations ; and
- (d) carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

The usual exceptions have also been provided in the proposed Order for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge.
