The Queen having been pleased to approve the appointment of Sir Erskine William Gladstone, Bt., D.L., as Vice Lord-Lieutenant of the County of Clwyd to act for Her Majesty's Lord-Lieutenant during his absence from the area, sickness or other inability to act a commission in his favour bearing the date 24th January 1984 has been signed by the Lord-Lieutenant. The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has, on the application of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, made an Order under section 212 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 extinguishing subject to some exceptions, any rights persons may have to use vehicles on the length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of Ogwr Borough Council Municipal Buildings, the Rhiw, Bridgend, Mid Glamorgan.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 2nd in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 2nd February 1984, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained

Any person who, at the time of the coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to the length of highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Mid Glamorgan County Council as the local planning authority in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable.

(All distances are approximate)

Description of highway to which this notice relates is at Bridgend in the County of Mid Glamorgan and is that length of Newcastle Hill which extends from its junction with Park Street in a general north-westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres. (4 SI)

The Trunk Road (A465) (Clydach Gorge, Gwent) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1 and 12 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended which shall come into operation on 12th February 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles proceeding in the eastbound carriageway of the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this notice from making a right-hand turn into the lay-by adjoining the westbound carriageway.
