ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Trunk Road (A180) (Brocklesby Interchange-Pyewipe Roundabout) (24 Hour Main Carriageway Clearway) Order 1984

- 1. The Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2), (3) and (3B) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in any part (other than in a lay-by) of that length of the (A180) Trunk Road in the Districts of Glanford and Cleethorpes in the County of Humberside extending from its junction with in the County of Humberside extending from its junction with the A160 trunk road at Brocklesby Interchange eastwards to its junction with Pyewipe Roundabout, a distance of approximately 12.25 kilometres.
- 2. Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle or vehicles to be used for so long as may be necessary in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the trunk road. Provision will

also be made for vehicles to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance services or any of the essential services in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties.

- A copy of the draft Order which together with a plan showing the length of road concerned and a statement of the Secretary of the length of road concerned and a statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the offices of Humberside County Council, County Hall, Beverley or the Glanford Borough Council Offices, Bigby Street, Brigg during office hours. Copies may be obtained by application to the Director (Transport), Yorkshire and Humberside Regional Office, 9th Floor, City House, Leeds LS1 4JD.
- 4. Any person desiring to object to the Secretary of State's proposal to make the Order should send not later than 7th March 1984, and to the address of the Director (Transport) given above, a written statement of his or her objection and the grounds thereof quoting reference DYH5060/41/2/TR22/4.
