NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DRAFT PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 26

The County of Cornwall (Pine Haven-Port Quin) Public Path Creation Order 198

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2 (3) of the Sixth Schedule to the Highways Act 1980, that the Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to modify the County of Cornwall (Pine Haven-Port Quin) Draft Public Path Creation Order 198, by providing for the line of the path to run from (1) the north-eastern corner of field OS No. 4711 (point X) and leading generally northwards for about 145 metres to a point on the southern boundary of O.S. No. 4841 (point C) instead of from point X following the northern boundary of field O.S. No. 4711 then the eastern boundary of field O.S. No. 4624 to point C; and (2) from a point on the boundary of O.S. No. 0400 (point D) leading south-westwards for 12 metres to the end of the coastal slope above Reedy Cliff instead of from point D leading in a loop into fields O.S. Nos. 0400 and 0103 and then to the end of the coastal slope.

A copy of the Order and map as drafted and a copy of the map showing the proposed modifications have been placed on deposit at the offices of Cornwall County Council at County Hall, Truro, and the North Cornwall District Council at the Municipal Offices, Priory Road, Bodmin, and may be inspected free of charges during normal office hours.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967, SECTION 12(1)

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order affecting the Winchester-Preston Trunk Road (A34) in the District of Newbury in the Royal County of Berkshire.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit vehicles on the northbound carriageway of the A34 Trunk Road from making a right hand turn into Sandford Priory and to prohibit vehicles from Sandford Priory from making a right hand turn into the northbound carriageway of the A34 Trunk Road.

The Order is necessary to enable drain laying to be carried out and will come into operation at 0700 hours on Monday, 20th February 1984, and end when the works have been completed (the works are expected to be completed in mid-March 1984).

The alternative routes for vehicles wishing to turn right is to:

- continue northwards to the Pinchington Lane Roundabout then southwards to turn left into Sandford Priory;
- turn left and proceed southwards to the Newton Roundabout then northward towards Newbury.
