The Borough of Scarborough (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Scarborough Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke and reproduce, with amendments, the provisions of The Borough of Scarborough (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1983 which controls the use of the following car parks:

- (1) The Spa, Scarborough
- (2) William Street, Scarborough
- (3) Runswick Bay Bank Bottom (Reserved Area)
- (4) Staithes, The Staith
- (5) Tin Ghaut, Whitby
- (6) Khyber Pass, Whitby
- (7) Midland Bank, Whitby
- (8) St. Hilda's Terrace (Back), Whitby.

The Order will:

- (a) Authorise in relation to Car Park No. 1 the following revised scale of charges:

Period	Cars and similar vehicles	Motor cycles
Per day or part	80p	20p
After 6.30 p.m.	20p	20p

- (b) Authorise in relation to Car Park No. 2.

(i) the introduction of a daily charge of 40p for cars and similar vehicles on all days except Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays during the period from Maundy Thursday until the third Sunday in October (when, space permitting, the charge will be 80p).

(ii) the introduction of a £10 parking permit for cars and similar vehicles valid on the same days as the 40p charge referred to at (i) above;

(iii) an increase to £50 in the charge for an annual parking permit for cars and similar vehicles (also valid at most Pay and Display car parks in Scarborough and Filey).

(iv) the introduction of a 3-day permit (£2.50) and a 7-day permit (£6) interchangeable at most other Council car parks.

- (c) Authorise a reduction from £65 to £50 in the charge for a seasonal exclusive-use parking permit at Car Park No. 6.

All other charges at the car parks specified will remain unaltered as will most conditions of use applicable to those car parks.

- (a) revoke and reproduce, subject to minor amendments, the provisions of an existing Order which controls the use of the West Pier Car Park and to authorise in relation to that car park a charge of £100 for an annual permit (except in the case of harbour-users for whom the charge will remain £50);

- (b) prohibit parking on the North Wharf and Vincent Pier except by operational vehicles; and

- (c) prohibit parking on the East Pier except by operational vehicles, Scarborough Yacht Club's vehicles and those of its members.
