WELSH OFFICE

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out.

During 28 days from 23rd February 1984 copies of the draft Order and the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge, at all reasonable hours at the offices of Cynon Valley Borough Council at Rock Grounds, High Street, Aberdare.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days any person may by notice to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Transport, Highways and Planning Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL (quoting ref. WR15/51/1), object to the making of the Order, stating the grounds for objection.

SCHEDULE

The highway to be stopped up is at Mountain Ash in the Borough of Cynon Valley in the county of Mid Glamorgan and is that length of Cardiff Road which extends from a point 5 yards from the nearest point to the junction with New Road (A4059) in a general north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 722 yards. The Trunk Road (A5) (Llanfairpwllgwyngyll, Gwynedd) (De-Restriction) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 72 and 73 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended which will come into operation on 19th March 1984.

The effect of the Order is to de-restrict the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

That length of the London-Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll, in the county of Gwynedd, which extends from a point 424 yards west of the junction of the trunk road with the Class III Holyhead Road in a general south-easterly direction to a point 19 yards south-east of the centre point of the bridge carrying the Llanfairpwll-Amlwch-Valley County Road (A5025) over the trunk road, a distance of 2,657 yards, including the entire lengths of the eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads connecting the main carriageway of the trunk road with the Llanfairpwll-Amlwch-Valley County Road (A5025).
