#### LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET

##### *The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. ) Order 198*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978, so that in the lengths of streets specified in the schedule to this notice and in the first 18.29 metres of adjacent Margaret Road:

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Barnet Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising would be prohibited.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(a) and (b) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "orange badge" would apply.

4. A copy of the proposed Order, of the Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order) and of the Council's statements of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published in Room B.72, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

6. Any person desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of his objection and the grounds thereof, to the Controller of Transportation and Development, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB, quoting ref. TD/T/LS, within the afore-mentioned period of 21 days.

#### SCHEDULE

*Church Walk*, the north-east and north-west sides, between a point opposite the boundary of Church Walk House, Church Walk and All Saints' Vicarage, Church Walk and a point 16.76 metres north-east of the south-westernmost wall of All Saints' Vicarage, Church Walk.

#### *Crewys Road.*

(a) the north-east side, between a point 18.29 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Cricklewood Lane and a point opposite the southern wall of No. 4 Crewys Road;

(b) the south-west side, between the northern kerb-line of Cricklewood Lane and a point opposite the southern wall of No. 4 Crewys Road.

*East Barnet Road*, the north-east side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 84 and 86 East Barnet Road and a point opposite the south-eastern wall of No. 85 East Barnet Road.

*Sweets Way*, between a point 18.29 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Friern Barnet Lane and a point 63.29 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

##### *The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 51) Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 8th May 1984 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978, so that:

(A) in the lengths of street specified in the Schedule to this notice:

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;

(b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;

(c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Barnet Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited;

(B) parking places provided for bicycles (not capable of being propelled by mechanical power) will be exempted from the provisions of the above-mentioned Order of 1978.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(A)(a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "orange badge" will apply.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 14th May 1984, and of the Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.72, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.
