HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Greater London Council (Docks Cut Route Stage 2 Cyprus By-pass, Newham) Side Roads Order 1981

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the above Order which was made by the Greater London Council under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, provides for:

(i) authorising the Council—

(a) to carry out improvements to lengths of East Ham Manor Way and Savage Gardens;
(b) to stop up lengths of East Ham Manor Way, Woolwich Manor Way, the public footpaths from Connaught Road to Leys Road and from Connaught Road to West Beckton Link Road;

(c) to construct a new highway in the form of a footpath over a length of Woolwich Manor Way to be stopped up; all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road which the Greater London Council are proposing to construct from (a) Connaught Road eastwards to connect with the West Beckton Link Road, (b) East Ham Manor Way in an easterly direction to connect with Woolwich Manor Way, and (c) Cyprus Place to the new road (b) above.

(ii) transferring the new highway to the highway authority specified therefor in the Order.
