THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road A483 (Newbridge, Ruabon and Johnstown By-Pass and Slip Roads, Side Roads) (Variation) Order 1984.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made under sections 12, 14, 125 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order, the effect of which is to authorise him to vary the powers conferred by the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (Newbridge, Ruabon and Johnstown By-Pass and Slip Roads, Side Roads) Order 1982 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1982 Order"), to enable him to modify the provisions of the Schedules and site plans number 6 (Alterations North of Overton Road, Ruabon) and 8 (Hafod Road and Other Alterations) of the 1982 Order.

Copies of the Order, of the relevant plans and of the 1982 Order have been placed on deposit at the Welsh Office, The Repository, Curran Embankment, Cardiff; The Welsh Office, Transport, Highways and Planning Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff; and at the offices of Clwyd County Council, Shire Hall, Mold, Clwyd; Wrexham Maelor Borough Council, the Guildhall, Wrexham; Ruabon Branch Library, High Street, Ruabon, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.
