In the Matter of Section 42 of the Supreme Court Act 1981 and in the Matter of Teresa Murphy

Upon reading the Notice of Motion dated the 16th day of July 1984 on behalf of H. M. Attorney General for an Order pursuant to section 42 of the Supreme Court 1981 namely that

- (i) No legal proceedings shall without the leave of the High Court or a Judge thereof be instituted by Theresa Murphy in any Court.
- (ii) That any legal proceedings instituted by Theresa Murphy in any Court before the making of the Order shall not be continued by Theresa Murphy without the leave of the High Court.
- (iii) That no application (other than application for leave under this section) shall without the leave of the High Court be made by Theresa Murphy in any legal proceedings instituted whether by Theresa Murphy or another in any Court.

And upon reading the affidavit of John Roland Ortieno sworn the 13th day of July 1984 and the exhibit(s) thereto;

And upon hearing Mr. Andrew Collins of Counsel on behalf of H. M. Attorney General and Mr. A. Salter on behalf of Theresa Murphy;

It is ordered that

- (i) No legal proceedings shall without the leave of the High Court or a Judge thereof be instituted by Theresa Murphy in any Court.
- (ii) That any legal proceedings instituted by Theresa Murphy in any Court before the making of the Order shall not be continued by Theresa Murphy without the leave of the High Court.
