OUR Troops are marching from their Quarters, in order to their Rendezvous in the Province of Alentejo. A Squadron of Britifh Ships will meet the Portugal Fleet from the Bahia, and Convey them from the Ilands. Two Dutch Men of War are going out with two Portugal Eaft-India Ships, and five Dutch Men of War more are under Sail to Convoy their Storefhips to Gibraltar. The King of Portugal's Brother has broke his Leg in Hunting, but it is thought that he is palt all danger. This Day arriv'd here the Trade from England.

Vienna, April 6. N. S. The Grand Mafter of the Teutonick Order, who is like. wife Coadjutor of Mentz, has taken the accuftomed Oaths to the Emperor, in Quality of Governour both of the Upper and Lower Silefia. On the Twenty ninth of the laft Month, Fourteen of the Knights of the Golden Fleece, who have been nominated to that Dignity at Frankfort, were Inftall'd in the Church of the Auguftin Friars with extraordinary Solemnity, and receiv'd the Collar of the Order from the Hands of his Imperial Majefty. The Swifs-General, Baron d'Erlagh, is very earneft in his Sollicitations for confiderable Arrears due to the Swifs Regiments in the Imperial Service, which are faid to amount to Three fundred thoufand Crowns. The Venetian Ambafiador, Vistor Zani, having made a very fplendid Entrance the day before, has had his firft Audience of the Emperor. His Imperial Majefty has fent back an Interpreter, who lately arriv'd here from Conftantinople with a Commiflion to Monfieur Taalman, who remains there as his Refident, formally to notify his MajeIty's Acceffion to the Imperial Crown, and to diftribute the Prefents that are ufual upon fuch Occafions. The Prince Efterhafi arrived here from Hungary upon the Second of this Month, and has reprefented to the Emperter, that feveral of the Senators, and other Members fummoned to appear at the General Diet for that King-
dom, to be held at Presburg, come hither daily, but thoie who pufs'd through Places that are in any manner fufpected to have the Plague, perform their Quarrentine upon the Road, where they expect farther Orders: Hereupon the Emperor Yeiterday, commanded the Great Chamberlain to acquaint him, that when they were all arriv'd at Presburg, and the Affairs of the Government in a proper Condition for his Reception, they fhould give him notice of it : In the mean time there is no day fix'd for his departure, nor are the Perfons appointed who fhould attend him in his Journey thither. Signior Odelfchalchi, the Pope's Nuncio is gone hence in his way to Poland. The Velt Marthal, Count Dann, is fo much indifpos'd, that it is thought he will not be able to make the approaching Campaign in Italy.

Schafbaufen, April 7. N. S. Monfieur Pudner, the Chancellor of the Abbot of St. Galle, having met with a Monk of Fifhingen, and fome other Perfons, in the Village of Mofnang in the County of Tockenburg, affembled the Commons, and made them Propofitions on the part of the Prelate his Mafter; upon which they divided, and part were for accepting them, but others for their rejection, as Captious and Infufficient; at laft they came to Blows, and the Chancellor, with his Company, were oblig'd to fly to a Place of Satety, being follow'd by thofe who had moft contributed to the inteltine Difentions. It is hop'd at Zurich, that this fmall Encounter may occafion the Abbot to defer the execution of his Defign, and that fome proper Method may be found out for an Accommodation. The General Diet was opened on the Fourth Inftant at Baden.
Cologn, April 12. NK.S. The Chapter of this Place having fent the Baron de Godenau, and Monfieur Veyder, to view the Fortifications of the Town of Bonne, which were faid to be in want of Reparations, they have executed their Commiffions, but their Report is not as yet made pabiick.
