WANSBECK DISTRICT COUNCIL

THE CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

As amended by The Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980

The Wansbeck District Council Smoke Control Orders Nos 1, 2, 3 and 4, 1985

Notice is hereby given that it is the intention of the Wansbeck District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the above-mentioned Act to make Orders entitled the Wansbeck District Council Smoke Control Orders Nos 1, 2, 3 and 4, 1985, declaring the areas described in the First Schedule hereto, to be Smoke Control Areas

Subject to the exemption provided by the Orders if on any day after the Orders have come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any buildings within the Smoke Control Areas, the occupier of the building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 (one hundred pounds) unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke, and any other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity

The classes of fireplace in the areas, which are specified in the Second Schedule hereto, shall be exempted

The Orders will not come into operation before 1st September 1986

Copies of the Orders and of maps referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Wansbeck Square, Ashington, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 25th February 1985

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Orders may by notice in writing to the Chief Executive, Wans-beck District Council, Wansbeck Square, Ashington, object to the Orders
