BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that on 21st February 1985, the Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers made the above Order

The Order will have the following effect

- (1) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the following lengths of road

Clifton Drive (for a distance of 9 metres south and 5 metres north of Cardigan Place)	West

Dover Road (for a distance of 5 metres east and west of entrance to Moorland Motors opposite Wood Park Road)	North

Hull Road (Coronation Street to Back Street adjacent to 45 Hull Road)	South

Ruskin Avenue (for a distance of 25 metres north of Clare Street)	West

Talbot Road (for a distance of 9 metres east and 5 metres west of junctions with Coleridge Road, Henthorne Street and Greenhill Place)	South
Talbot Road (Hardman Street to Victory Road)	South
West Park Drive (for a distance of 15 metres south of Parks Offices entrance)	East
West Street (Market Street to Promenade)	South
Back Clevedon Road (Back Street off Back Egerton Road)	Both
Back Egerton Road (Rear of properties 2-32 Egerton Road)	Both
Back High Street (for a distance of 15 metres north of Banks Street)	East

- (2) Waiting will be prohibited at any time during the period 15th May to 31st October on the following length of road

Street	Side
Bond Street (for a distance of 5 metres north and 80 metres south of Pleasure Beach Coach Park entrance)	West

- (3) Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a m and 6 p m, Monday to Saturday inclusive, during the period 15th May to 31st October on the following length of road

Street	Side
Clare Street for the whole of its length	North

- (4) Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 7 a m and 7 p m in the bus stop areas in Adelaide Street, Bank Hey Street and Clifton Street

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st April 1985, and of a map showing the roads affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the address below

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Various Streets, Paignton) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, extending the consolidating waiting restrictions in Paignton

When the proposed Order comes into effect, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle

- (1) at any time in the following lengths of road
- Dartmouth Road, East side, from its junction with Saltern Road northwards and southwards for a distance of 50 metres (a total of 100 metres)
 - Dendy Road, South side, from the boundary of Nos 19-21 to the boundary of Nos 21-23 (i.e. a distance of 11 metres)
 - Primley Park, Both sides, from its junction with Totnes Road westwards for a distance of 260 metres
 - Winner Hill Road, East side, from its junction with Monastery Road southwards for a distance of 170 metres
 - Service Road between Norman Road and Esplanade Road, Both sides, from its junction with Lower Polsham Road for a distance of 30 metres
- (2) between the hours of 8 a m and 6 p m daily in the following length of road
- Lower Polsham Road, South side, from its junction with Barum Close for a distance of 8 metres westwards and 8 metres eastwards (i.e. a total of 16 metres)
