Middlesbrough Borough Council (Residents Parking Scheme) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Middlesbrough Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order will be that no person will be allowed to leave their vehicle between 8 a m to 6 p m Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on parts of the following roads unless the vehicle displays a valid parking permit

Emerald Street	Percy Street/Stowe Street
Ruby Street	St Aidans Street
Pelham Street	Tennyson Street
Portman Street	Peel Street
	Palmer Street

The permits will only be issued to residents and certain visitors in respect of passenger vehicles, dual purpose vehicles, goods vehicles with under 30 cwt, disabled persons vehicles or motorcycles

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of

(a) picking up and setting down passengers,

(b) loading or unloading goods,

and where necessary, in connection with

(c) the maintenance of the road, and

(d) supply of gas, electricity and water

Middlesbrough Borough Council (Gresham Ward) (Traffic Management Scheme) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Middlesbrough Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order will be

(i) to prohibit waiting Mondays to Saturdays 8 a m to 6 p m and on lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 1

(ii) To limit waiting Mondays to Saturdays 8 a m to 6 p m for longer than 2 hours with no return within

1 hour on lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 2

There will be exceptions which will permit waiting for the purposes of

(a) picking up and setting down passengers ,

(b) loading or unloading goods ,

and where necessary in connection with

(c) the maintenance of the roads ,

(d) supply of gas, electricity and water ,

(e) the delivery or collection of postal packets and

(f) any fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes

Disabled person's vehicles will be permitted to park for up to 2 hours on the sides and in the lengths of road in Schedule 1 and there will be total exemption for disabled persons' vehicles in relation to the road in Schedule 2

There are other exceptions in the draft Order, which can be inspected (together with the plan showing the restricted areas), at the following addresses between the hours of 9 a m and 4 30 p m Mondays to Fridays
