#### LLANELLI BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Llanelli Borough (Old Road and Harries Avenue) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1985*

Notice is hereby given that the Llanelli Borough Council (on behalf of and with the authority of the Dyfed County Council) propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2) and 2 (1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, in either of the sides of road or in the length of road in the Borough of Llanelli described below

(a) *Old Road, Llanelli*

(i) on its north-eastern side, between a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with Harries Avenue and a point 40 metres south-east of that junction,

(ii) on its south-western side, between a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with Harries Avenue and a point 20 metres south-east of that junction.

(b) *Harries Avenue, Llanelli*, between its junction with Old Road and a point 20 metres south-west of that junction

Exceptions will permit waiting

(a) for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers,

(b) for the purposes of loading or unloading goods,

(c) by disabled persons' vehicles for periods of 2 hours (with return prohibited within 1 hour),

(d) in connection with building operations;

(e) in connection with the maintenance of roads and services

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted area and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the offices of the Borough Solicitor, Second Floor, Ty Elwyn, Town Hall Square, Llanelli, during normal office hours

#### MACCLESFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Borough of Macclesfield (Altrincham Road (Part) Styal) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

*The Macclesfield Borough Council (High Street (Part) and Maple Avenue (Part) Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

*Borough of Macclesfield (Byrons Lane (Part) Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

*Borough of Macclesfield (Macclesfield Road (Part) and Shirleys Drive, Prestbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

Notice is hereby given that the Macclesfield Borough Council acting pursuant to arrangements made with Cheshire County Council in accordance with section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 propose to make the above Orders in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Orders will be as follows

(1) *Borough of Macclesfield (Altrincham Road (Part) Styal) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

To prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of Altrincham Road, Styal

*North side*, from its junction with Hollins Lane for a distance of 298 metres in a westerly direction

*South side*

(i) from its junction with Styal Road for a distance of 31 metres in a westerly direction,

(ii) from a point 112 metres west of its junction with Styal Road for a distance of 41 metres in a westerly direction

The existing Orders effecting these lengths of road will be revoked

(2) *Borough of Macclesfield (High Street (Part) and Maple Avenue (Part) Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

To prohibit waiting at any time of the following lengths of High Street and Maple Avenue, Macclesfield

*High Street*, both sides, from its junction with Maple Avenue for a distance of 16 metres in a northerly direction

*Maple Avenue* both sides, from its junction with High Street, for a distance of 13 metres in a westerly direction

(3) *Borough of Macclesfield (Byrons Lane (Part) Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

To prohibit waiting at any time on both sides of Byrons Lane from its junction with London Road to a point 120 metres south-west of its junction with Laburnum Road

(4) *Borough of Macclesfield (Macclesfield Road (Part) and Shirleys Drive Prestbury) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

To prohibit waiting

(1) At any time

*Macclesfield Road*

(i) From a point 100 metres south-east of its junction with The Village to a point 50 metres south of its junction with Shirleys Drive

(ii) On the west side, from a point 100 metres south-east of its junction with The Village to the south side of its junction with Ashbrook Drive

*Shirleys Drive*

(i) On the north-west side, from its junction with Macclesfield Road for its entire length, including the turning head

(ii) On the south-east side, from its junction with Macclesfield Road for a distance of 47 metres in a north-easterly direction

Access Road to Public Car Park, both sides, from its junction with Shirleys Drive for a distance of 45 metres in a north-easterly direction

(2) *No waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday*

*Macclesfield Road*, on the east side, from a point 50 metres south of its junction with Shirleys Drive to its junction with Ashbrook Drive

*Shirleys Drive*, on the south-east side, from a point 51 metres north-east of its junction with Macclesfield Road to the turning head

Exemptions in respect of all four Orders will include in respect of the loading and unloading of goods, the supply of gas, water and electricity, building or demolition operations the setting down and picking up of passengers and disabled drivers' vehicles

Copies of the Orders, maps and statement of reasons may be inspected during normal office hours at the Service Centre, Town Hall, Macclesfield. The documents in respect of Orders 2, 3 and 4 may be inspected during normal opening hours at the Public Library, Park Green, Macclesfield. The documents in respect of Order No 1 may be inspected during normal office hours at the Service Centre, Council Offices, South Drive, Wilmslow, and during normal opening hours at the Public Library, South Drive, Wilmslow. The documents in respect of Order No 4 may also be inspected during normal opening hours at the Public Library, the Reading Rooms, Prestbury
