#### PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

THE CIVIL SERVICE ORDER IN COUNCIL 1985

At the Court at Buckingham Palace the 15th day of May 1985 present.

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council Whereas by the Civil Service Order in Council 1982 (here-inafter referred to as "the principal Order") (a), provision was made for certifying the qualifications of person proposed for appointment to situations in Her Majesty's

Home Civil Service and for regulating the conduct of Her Majesty's Home Civil Service and the conditions of service therein

And whereas it is expedient to make additional provision in respect of certain appointments to situations in Her Majesty's Home Civil Service and Diplomatic Service without a certificate of qualification

Now therefore, Her Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows

1 In respect of any appointment on secondment, made on or after 1st December 1978 and before 19th March 1985, to a situation in Her Majesty's Home Civil Service
