

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 3rd June 1985 will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the following sides of Wakefield Road Service Road, off Lathese Crescent at New Lodge, Barnsley

North-east side, from its junction with the south-eastern kerb-line of Lathese Crescent in a generally south-easterly direction to its south-eastern termination and including the turning area

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicle are also included in the Order

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 3rd June 1985 will be to prohibit any persons from riding or causing to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle in either of the footpaths described in the Schedule to this notice at Ardsley in the metropolitan borough of Barnsley
