

## MIDDLESBROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Middlesbrough Borough Council (Ulla Street)  
Restriction of Waiting Order 1985*

Notice is hereby given that Middlesbrough Borough Council acting as agent for the Highway Authority, Cleveland County Council, have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into operation on 1st July 1985

The effect of this Order is to restrict the waiting of vehicles to 1 hour in any period of 3 hours in the side of the road set out in the Schedule below. Vehicles must be parked at an angle of 90 degrees to the kerb.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers,
- (b) loading or unloading goods, and where necessary, in connection with
- (c) the maintenance of the roads, and
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water,
- (e) the delivering or collecting of postal packages,
- (f) any fire brigade, ambulance or police services

A copy of the Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the offices of the Borough Secretary, Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough and Middlesbrough Information Centre, 125 Albert Road, Middlesbrough, Cleveland, free of charge during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the power of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or any enactment made under it is not being complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of the making of the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Granby) (30 m p h Speed Limit) Order 1985*

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 m p h on the following length of road.

That length of Sutton Lane at Granby in the Borough of Rushcliffe, extending from a point 146 metres north-east of the Main Street junction in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 174 metres.

## PRESTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Preston Borough Council (Hartington Road and Christ  
Church Street) (Parking Places and Traffic Regulation)  
Order 1985*

Notice is hereby given that the Preston Borough Council, as agent of the highway authority, the Lancashire County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 49, 53, 124 (1) (d) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, has made on 17th June 1985 the above Order. The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 30th June 1985, is as follows:

(1) To designate areas on certain specified highways as parking places for the use at any time of any passenger vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, goods vehicle or motor cycle, the owner of which is a resident in any of certain specified streets and has obtained from the Council and displays on his vehicle in the prescribed manner a permit in respect of that vehicle, the charge in respect of which will be £5 per annum and which will expire on 30th June in each year.

(2) To make provision for the way in which the operation of the scheme shall be regulated. The highways of which part will be designated as parking places are as follows:

Christ Church Street  
Hartington Road

The streets in one of which must be resident in order to qualify for the issue of a permit are as follows:

Christ Church Street  
Hartington Road (east side up to No 116)

(3) Subject to the usual exemptions, to limit waiting to a period of two hours, with return prohibited within two hours, or to prohibit waiting completely, between the hours of 8 a m and 6 p m from Monday to Saturday in certain lengths of Christ Church Street and Hartington Road.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing street affected, a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Borough Solicitor's Department, Town Hall, Preston, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the above sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the ground that any requirement of any section of that Act or any regulations made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 17th June 1985, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## ST ALBANS DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The St Albans District Council (Sandringham Crescent/  
House Lane, Sandridge) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed  
Limit) Order 1984*

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers contained in the Acts quoted, or on the ground that any requirement of those Acts or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 28th June 1985, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
