4 Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50 000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates

5 Tenders must be made through a London Banker Discount House or Broker

6 Notification will be sent on the same day as Tenders are received to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part Payment in full of the amounts due in respect of such accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1979

To Mr Kevin Henry

Pursuant to section 139 (6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 and paragraph 1 of the 3rd Schedule thereto the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the customs and excise Acts and any enactments amending those Acts certain goods namely

a vehicle described as a Peugeot 504 GLD registration number TBY 61W have been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the ground(s) that

(1) The said vehicle being a road vehicle was found to contain rebated heavy oil being used as fuel for the engine provided for propelling the said vehicle contrary to section 12 (2) of the Hydrocarbon Oil Duties Act 1979

(2) The said heavy oil is liable to forfeiture under section 13 (6) (a) of the Hydrocarbon Oil Duties Act 1979

(3) The said vehicle is a vehicle which has been used for the carriage and concealment of the said heavy oil

Whereby and by force of section 141 (1) (a) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 the said goods are liable to forfeiture

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a solicitor in England and Wales who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf In default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct If you make such claim within the time aforesaid legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof
