SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Solihull Smoke Control Order (No. 35) 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act propose to make an Order entitled "The Solihull Smoke Control Order (No. 35) 1985" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council House, Solihull, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council, object to the making of the Order.

SCHEDULE

Description of area

An area in the Packwood Ward, bounded by the front boundaries of 179 to 161 Mill Lane; the west and rear boundary of No. 145 and the rear and eastern boundary of No. 143 Mill Lane; the front boundary of No. 135 and Dorridge Methodist Church, Mill Lane; the eastern boundary of the Methodist Church and the rear boundaries of 151 to 103 Poplar Road; the southern boundary of No. 103 and the eastern boundary of the railway sidings, Poplar Road; the rear boundary of 61 to 47 Poplar Road; the south-eastern boundary of No. 47 Poplar Road and front boundary of No. 1 Fennis Close and 43 Poplar Road; the southern boundary of 43 and rear boundaries of 41 to 27 Poplar Road; and the southern boundary of No. 18 Fennis Close; the centre line of the railway; the rear boundary of 189 to 181 and east boundary of 181 Mill Lane.
