NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

Milton Keynes Development Corporation: Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way over Part of former Groveway, West Ashland.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981 has made an Order extinguishing as from the date of the Order public rights of way over the following routes shown by a broken black line on the map referred to therein.

That part of former Groveway from a point marked A on the map being its junction with the Redway at the west side of the subway passing under Saxon Street, City Road V7, running in a south-westerly direction for approximately 230 metres to a point marked B on the map being its junction with the Groveway, City Road H.9.

The Trunk Road (Filleymeads Staffordshire) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1963 (Revocation) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on a length of the Winchester-Preston Trunk Road (A34) known locally as the Filleymeads, near Stone, in the Borough of Stafford, in the County of Staffordshire.

The effect of the Order will be to revoke the Order made in 1963 which restricted to one way the movement of traffic through the two gaps in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite its junction with the B5027 (Newcastle Road), because the northernmost of these gaps has been closed and traffic signals installed at the other gap, removing the need for the restriction. A copy of the Order, a copy of the Order to be revoked, and a statement explaining the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during office hours at the offices of Staffordshire County
