goods vehicles being loaded or unloaded at premises fronting onto or only accessible from Commercial Street, Aberdare.

The Order came into operation on 16th December 1985 and a copy thereof and a map showing the length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the Offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from the 16th December 1985.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the 16th December 1985, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
