EXPLANATORY NOTE:

The Department of Health and Social Security propose to make amendments to the Housing Benefits Regulations to exclude from eligibility people provided with accommodation under Part III of the National Assistance Act 1948, Section 59 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 and section 21 of the National Health Services Act 1977. Where such residents claim housing benefit, the effect is generally to reduce the cost to the local authority of providing the accommodation rather than benefit the claimants themselves. The responsibility for providing

such accommodation lies with social services departments, and the Government considers that the cost should not be subsidised through the housing benefits scheme.
