

(i) between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(ii) between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

(iii) between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(c) on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be changed so that, unless otherwise prohibited as in sub-paragraph (b) above, such prohibition will apply between 8 a.m. and midnight on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in The Broadway, Ealing, the east to west arm and in the lengths of New Broadway and The Mall specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 10th February 1986, and of the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.72. 5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

(a) the east side, between its junction with The Mall and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 35 and 36 The Broadway, Ealing;

(b) the west side, between its junction with the east to west arm of The Broadway, Ealing and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 38 and 39 The Broadway, Ealing.

The Mall

(a) the north side, between its junction with The Broadway, Ealing and a point 2 metres west of a point opposite the western wall of No. 1 The Mall;

(b) the south side, between its junction with The Broadway, Ealing and the western kerb-line of Windsor Road.

The Broadway, Ealing, the east to west arm:

The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 35) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 24th January 1986 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977, so that:

(a) in the length of street specified in Schedule 1 to this notice the prohibitions imposed by that Order on waiting by vehicles, on the sale of goods and on advertising activities will no longer apply;

(b) in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice:

(i) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

(ii) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
