#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the South Western Division of the Welsh Water Authority by G. R. E. Stratford, West Atheston, Valley Road, Narberth, Pembrokeshire, for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of unnamed tributary of Narberth Brook by means of impounding works at Grid Ref.
