THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The A483 Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road and the A489 Newton-Aberystwyth Trunk Road (Dolfor Road Junction Improvement, Newtown, Side Roads) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby give notice that he proposes in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Roads at Dolfor Road Junction, Newtown in the county of Powys, to make under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order which will:

(a) Authorise him:

- (i) to construct a new highway to connect Crynfryn Place with the A483 Trunk Road,
- (ii) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (iii) to provide new means of access to premises,
- (b) to provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the Powys County Council of Powys County Hall, Llandrindod Wells, Powys, as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Order and the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 26th February 1986 until 9th April 1986, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the Welsh Office, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings,

COTTON WASTE RECLAMATION WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN)

The Cotton Waste Reclamation Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of proposals for (1) varying the provisions relating to statutory minimum remuneration, holidays and holiday remuneration as set out in the Wages (Cotton Waste Reclamation) Order 1985 (Order CW111); and (2) the revocation of Order CW111.

The Wages Council intends that he revised provisions shall come into operation on 21st April 1986.
