NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

Telford Development Corporation: Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way over Part of Footpath No. 14

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following route shown by a broken black line, coloured red on the map, hereinafter referred to:

That part of footpath No. 14 from a point marked A on the map, being its junction with the proposed Eastern District Road (South) and situated approximately 200 metres south of the Woodhouse, and running for a distance of approximately 225 metres in a generally southerly direction to a point marked B on the map, being approximately 150 metres north of the northern shore of the Priorslee Balancing Lake.

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished and the alternative route to be provided may be inspected at the offices of the Telford Development Corporation, Priorslee Hall, Telford, during normal office hours. Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing clearly stating all the grounds of the objection and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Room C12/03, 2 Marsham Street, London SWIP 3EB (ref. NT/5461/U19/3/11), not later than 11th April 1986.
