A Statute made by the Governing Body of Jesus College, in the University of Oxford, on 12th March 1986, amending Statutes III, IV, VIII, XVIII and XIX has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its submission is published in accordance with the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The Statute amends provisions governing the retirement age for certain Official and Senior Research Fellows and for College Officers. (17 SI)
