

of the method applying for permits will be made known to residents at the appropriate time. "Resident" means any person whose usual residence is at premises, the postal address of which is in the roads specified in Schedule 4 to this notice.

In the case of (ii) and (iii) above, exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour in the case of (ii) above and at any time in the case of (iii) above.

In the case of (iv) above, exemptions will be provided in the Order to allow boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, the maintenance of essential services, roadworks, funerals, weddings and doctors and veterinary surgeons to visit while "on call".

Sides of lengths of roads in the Borough of Taff Ely Prohibition of waiting at any time

(a) Northern side of John Street, Treforest, from its junction with Park Street eastwards to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 1-2, a distance of approximately 30 metres (33 yards).

(b) Southern side of John Street, Treforest, from its junction with Park Street eastwards to its junction with the western side of John Place, a distance of approximately 23 metres (25 yards).

(c) Southern side of John Street, Treforest, from its junction with the eastern side of John Place, eastwards to the common boundary of Nos. 11-12 a distance of approximately 10 metres (11 yards).

(d) Western side of John Place, Treforest, from its junction with John Street southwards for a distance of 14 metres (15 yards).
