

Under Article 7 (1) G, of EEC Directive 64/432 (as amended), by way of Derogation from Article 3 (3) (e), female animals of less than 30 months of age intended for meat production need not be tested for enzootic bovine leukosis. They shall be marked by means of a metal tag with a blue plastic disc, in the left ear.
