The Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road A27 Brighton By-pass (Mile Oak Side Roads) Order 198

ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The Bath-Lincoln Trunk Road A46 (Upper Swainswick to A420 Cold Ashton Roundabout) Compulsory Purchase Order (No. SW) 198 .

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts has prepared a draft Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above, which he proposes to make, authorising him to purchase compulsorily:

(ii) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the said Parishes in the said Districts and County in pursuance of the Bath-Lincoln Trunk Road A46 (Upper Swainswick to A420 Cold Ashton Roundabout, Side Roads) Order 198 .

(iii) the improvement of the A46 Trunk Road in the Parishes of Swainswick and Cold Ashton in the said Districts and County, and

(iv) the execution of works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road, and

(v) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;

(b) the land described in Schedule 2 hereto for the purpose of mitigating any adverse effect which the existence or use of certain of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved by him as mentioned above will have on the surroundings thereof.
