

**Welham Street**

West side, from its junction with East Street to a point 10 metres south of the southern boundary of East Street.

West side, between points 18 metres and 27 metres north of the northern boundary of Avenue Road.

East side, from its junction with Stonebridge Road to its junction with East Street at the north-eastern corner.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in con-

nection with the supply of gas, electricity and water and any telegraphic line.

A copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at County Offices, Lincoln, and the offices of the South Kesteven District Council, Council Offices, St. Vincent's, Grantham, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 23rd May 1986.
