NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO
ABSTRACT WATER AND TO VARY AN EXISTING
LICENCE.

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn-Trent Water Authority by R. E. Morley & Partners, of Staplehill Farm, Wellesbourne, Warwickshire, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from a tributary of River Avon at the following points of abstraction: 22,725 cubic metres per annum at SP 298 541 in the Parish of Moreton Morrell, and to vary existing licence number 18/54/13/71.

Further details of the application are: Water is to be abstracted into storage in the winter for spray irrigation in summer. Variation of 18/54/13/71 is to link existing land and reservoir with proposed new licence.

TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Southern Water Authority by Whitbread Breweries, Whitbread House, Park Street, West Luton, Bedfordshire, to vary licence serial number 9/40/2/78/GR to abstract water from The Chalk at their Brewery at Faversham, Kent, at or near Grid ref.
