EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Eastleigh (Portsmouth Road, Lowford) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1986

SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

New Traffic Proposals for the County of South Glamorgan

Notice is hereby given that the County of South Glamorgan, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends imposing traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in column 1 of the Schedule below.

The nature of the restriction is shown in column 2 of the Schedule and the titles of the proposed Orders are shown in column 3.
