ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (City Centre Area, Plymouth) (Traffic Regulation) Amendment Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit the driving of motor vehicles and the riding of pedal bicycles and tricycles on parts of the roads specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Notice.

2. To prohibit the waiting and the loading and unloading of vehicles at any time on parts of the roads specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice.

3. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time and the loading and unloading of vehicles between 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on parts of the roads specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice.

4. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on parts of the roads specified in Schedule 6 to this Notice.

5. To revoke The City of Plymouth (New George Street) ("U" turn) order 1968 and The County of Devon (Market Avenue Area, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Unloading) Amendment Order 1978.

6. To revoke The City of Plymouth (Various Streets) ("U" turns) Order 1966 insofar as it relates to New George Street and Raleigh Street.

7. To revoke The County of Devon (City Centre Area, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Loading and Unloading) Amendment Order 1982 insofar as it relates to Cornwall Street, Armada Way and Courtenay Street.

8. To amend Paragraph 2(1) of The County of Devon (Royal Parade, Plymouth) (Reserved Bus Lane) Order 1977 by replacing in the second line the word "the" with the word "any".

9. To Revoke The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Plymouth) (No. 1) Order 1970 as amended insofar as it relates to the following parts:

Schedule 1	Designated Parking Places—Numbers 1 to 41, 46 and 47.
Schedule 2, Part I	Roads where Waiting is prohibited during the restricted hours—insofar as it relates to parts of the roads specified in Schedule 7 to this Notice.
Schedule 2, Part II	Roads where Waiting, Loading and Unloading is prohibited at all times for all purposes—insofar as it relates to parts of the roads specified in Schedule 8 to this Notice.
Schedule 3	One Way Street—insofar as it relates to parts of the roads specified in Schedule 9 to this notice.
Schedule 4	Cycle Parking Places—Numbers C.1 to C.21.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to all roads cited in Paragraph 1 above permitting motor vehicles to proceed for the purposes of major building industrial or demolition operations, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services, emergency service vehicles, pedestrian controlled vehicles and the towing of a display/caravan unit.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to the roads cited in Schedule 2 of Paragraph 1 permitting motor vehicles to proceed to gain access to rear court parking and loading areas.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to the road cited in Schedule 3 of Paragraph 1 permitting bulk paper delivery vehicles to the Newspaper Printing Works to rear court loading area.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to Paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 above permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, building and demolition, roadworks, maintenance of essential services, hackney carriages waiting on a duly authorised rank, invalid vehicles waiting on designated parking areas for a maximum period of 2 hours, and vehicles used by disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to Paragraphs 3 and 4 above permitting waiting for the purposes of loading and unloading and in respect of Paragraph 3 between the hours of 6 p.m. and 9 a.m. Monday to Saturday and in respect of Paragraph 4 at any time.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the address given below.
