TRIAL OF THE PYX 1986
VERDICT

1. We, the undersigned, were duly sworn on the 13th February 1986 before the Queen's Remembrancer at Goldsmiths' Hall in the City of London to assay gold, silver Maundy, silver, cupro-nickel and nickel brass coins of Her Majesty, which were produced to us by officers of the Royal Mint. Accounts of the Deputy Master of the
