**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. ) Order 1986*

Notice is hereby given that the Southend-on-Sea Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to prohibit and restrict waiting in Byrne Drive and Fairlawn Gardens as follows:

<i>Fairlawn Gardens</i> , both sides, from a point adjacent to the boundary between Nos. 17-18 Fairlawn Gardens eastwards to include the turning head.	24 hours daily.
<i>Byrne Drive</i> , north side, from a point 20 metres west of the west kerb-line of Fairlawn Gardens to a point 15 metres east of the east kerb-line of Marlow Gardens.	9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, January, March, May, July, September, November.
<i>Byrne Drive</i> , south side, from a point 15 metres west of the west kerb-line of Beverley Gardens to a point 15 metres east of the east kerb-line of Marlow Gardens.	9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, February, April, June, August, October, December.
<i>Fairlawn Gardens</i> , east side, from a point 15 metres north of the north kerb-line of Byrne Drive northwards to the south kerb-line of the east/west leg of Fairlawn Gardens.	9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, January, March, May, July, September, November.
<i>Fairlawn Gardens</i> , west side, from a point 15 metres north of the north kerb-line of Byrne Drive northwards to the south kerb-line of the east/west leg of Fairlawn Gardens.	9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, February, April, June, August, October, December.
<i>Fairlawn Gardens</i> , north side, the east/west leg from a point opposite the boundary between Nos. 17 and 18 Fairlawn Gardens to a point opposite the boundary between Nos. 32 and 33 Fairlawn Gardens.	9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, January, March, May, July, September, November.

*Length of road*

*Fairlawn Gardens*, south side, the east/west leg from a point opposite the boundary between Nos. 17 and 18 Fairlawn Gardens to a point opposite the boundary between Nos. 32 and 33 Fairlawn Gardens.

*Hours of prohibition*

9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, February, April, June, August, October, December.

**OPENCAST COAL ACT 1958**
